## Pavement Repairs Scheduled

TM Asphalt Sealing & J. Allen Asphalt will be working in the Resort starting August 11. Asphalt repairs are planned for these locations:

- Beside the new curb on N. Beach Loop.
- Fill in the three horseshoes on Lakeshore Dr.
- Cut & replace bad pavement at lot 49.
- Fill in pavement on Hammond Dr. cul-de-sac.
- Cut & replace bad pavement across from office.
- Crack fill pavement at lot 65 & lower clubhouse parking area.

In addition, they will sealcoat and re-stripe Klines Resort Rd. from Silver St. to the intersection of Center St. Please be patient and cautious around the work. If you live in the vicinity of these repairs, please move any parked cars out of the way. If you will be away from the resort, do not leave parked vehicles in these areas.

## COVID-19 UPDATE

As of this writing, these restrictions remain in place:

- **Masks required:** Inside office, clubhouse, or when unable to social distance outside.
- **Occupancy Limits:** Max 10 people in clubhouse, 5 guests in office, 2 people in elevator and fish house, 1 family group in laundry and restrooms.
- **Clubhouse:** Dining room and basement are closed. No private parties. (Private parties up to 50 people may reserve the tent.)
- **Social Distance:** Keep 6 ft spacing at all times. This includes playground, beach, courts, etc.
- **Self Isolate:** If you exhibit any symptoms or have been in contact with a person who has Covid-19, you must self isolate for 14 days or until you test negative.

**Yard Sales Sept 12:** Let office know if you plan to have a sale at your house so we can add you to the map!

**Storage Lot Hours: 7 am to 9 pm.** Don't get locked inside when we come to lock up at 9.

**Boats, RV's, & trailers must be put in storage overnight. No parking on street, in yards, alleys, etc.** Remember to get it put away before 9 when the storage lot closes.
